**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at noon by Vice-Chairman, Jon Wilde

**Minutes:** Hugh Straatman made a motion to approve the December minutes, seconded by Kolby Hullinger. Motion carried.

**Finances:** Kolby Hullinger made a motion to approve payment of two invoices: \$55.00 for stamps, \$60.24 for office supplies. AJ Olsen seconded the motion. Motion carried. Kolby Hullinger made a motion to pay the \$625.00 for UACD dues, seconded by Hugh Straatman. Motion carried.

Hugh Straatman made a motion to approve the reconciliation report and financial report, seconded by AJ Olsen. Motion carried.

Matt Tippetts reported that the County amended its budget to include \$2,000.00 for conservation contributions to the Daggett Conservation District. The County will pay the past due amount of \$1,000 and will need an invoice for the 2020 request of \$500.00.

**Weed Reimbursements:** No reimbursements. Two residents have paid their weed invoices to date and weed spraying for the airport is not reimbursable.

**Equipment Purchases, Bids:** The County received three bids for weed spraying equipment. Hugh Straatman made a motion to accept the bid from Warren Chemicals for \$4200.00, seconded by Kolby Hullinger. Motion carried.

The County will need to set up an account with Warren Chemical. Warren will deliver the equipment as far as Evanston, Wyoming.

**NRCS:** The Conservation Stewardship Program focuses on enhancement ideas.

**USU** will be sponsoring a soil health workshop on February 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup>.

**UCC:** The next meeting will be January 16<sup>th</sup>. They are currently drafting the language for appointing supervisors which will need to be presented to the State Legislature.

**UGIP:** They will be sponsoring a grazing work group meeting on January 14<sup>th</sup> and will take the results of this meeting to various government agencies. They are still taking signups.
