RESOLUTION NO 06-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DAGGETT COUNTY, UTAH, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUE OF A LOCAL 1% SALES AND USE TAX FOR HEALTH CARE TO BE INCLUDED ON THE BALLOT FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION SCHEDULED TO BE HELD ON THE 27<sup>th</sup> DAY OF JUNE, 2006, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZATION OF THE IMPOSITION OF A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX OF 1% TO FUND RURAL COUNTY HEALTH CARE FACILITIES IN DAGGETT COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Section 59-18-802 and Title 11, Chapter 14, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, require the Board of County Commissioners to publish or post a Notice of Election regarding the imposition of a local sales and use tax of 1% to fund Rural County Health Care Facilities in Daggett County, and

WHEREAS, a Ballot Question may be submitted at any general, primary or other election held in the county and the election officials serving for the other election may also serve as election officials for the Ballot Question; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Daggett County has a duty to prescribe the form of the ballot and various other forms and General election procedures; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 General Session of the legislature, through HB 193, amended applicable state statutes to authorize Daggett County, a county of the 6<sup>th</sup> Class, with approval of the public, to impose a sales and use tax of up to 1% for emergency medical services; federally qualified health centers; free-standing urgent care centers; rural county health care facilities; rural health clinics; or a combination of the above. The monies generated by the tax by a county of the 6<sup>th</sup> Class may only be used for the financing of (i) on-going operating expenses of the center, clinic or facilities described in UCA §59-12-802(1)(a)(ii)(B) within Daggett County or the provision of rural emergency medical services in Daggett County; and

WHEREAS, the tax must be authorized by vote of the public and shall be levied for a period of ten (10) years and may be re-authorized at the end of the ten (10) year period by the county legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the Daggett County Commission believes that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Daggett County, State of Utah that the sales tax of 1% be imposed and collected for the purposes set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Daggett County resolves as follows:

1. A notice of a Ballot Question to be placed on the general ballot shall be prepared and posted for the purpose of authorization of the imposition of a local sales and use tax of 1% to fund Rural County Health Care Facilities in Daggett County. Said notice shall be posted in five (5) public places in the County, for three consecutive weeks,

**PROPOSITION**

**SHALL THE DAGGETT COUNTY COMMISSION BE AUTHORIZED TO IMPOSE A SALES AND USE TAX OF UP TO 1% TO FUND:**

- (i) EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES IN DAGGETT COUNTY;**
- (ii) FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS IN DAGGETT COUNTY;**
- (iii) FREE-STANDING URGENT CARE CENTERS IN DAGGETT COUNTY;**
- (iv) RURAL COUNTY HEALTH CARE FACILITIES IN DAGGETT COUNTY;**
- (v) RURAL HEALTH CLINICS;**
- (vi) OR A COMBINATION OF THE ABOVE AS PROVIDED BY UCA §59-12-802, AS AMENDED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006.**

the first posting of which shall be not less than 21 days before the election. The Notice shall be posted in form and content as follows:

### ELECTION NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Daggett County, Utah have called for a question to be placed on the Ballot, for the purpose of authorization of the imposition of a local sales and use tax of 1% to fund Rural County Health Care Facilities in Daggett County. Polling places, time and election officials will be the same as already established by the County Clerk for the Primary Election. All qualified voters shall be entitled to vote either for or against the proposal. The Primary Election will be held on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2006, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. + 8:00 P.M.

2. The Board of County Commissioners, hereby directs the County Clerk and all other appropriate officers and employees of the County to take all actions necessary and appropriate to conduct the Election specified herein and that the Election be conducted in accordance with State law as to voting, registration, challenges to voters, judges, ballot forms, sample ballots, absentee voting, canvass, notice of results, and all other election procedures.
3. The ballot page layout shall be in a form prescribed by law and similar to that attached as Exhibit A.
4. The Resolution shall take effect without publication immediately upon its adoption by the Board and the County Clerk is hereby directed to post the Election Notice.
