

RESOLUTION 13-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DAGGETT COUNTY, UTAH APPOINTING AN AGRICULTURE PROTECTION AREA ADVISORY BOARD FOR DAGGETT COUNTY, UTAH.

The Board of Commissioners of Daggett County, Utah, referred to in this resolution as the "County Commission," state the following as the basis for adopting this resolution:

A. The Utah Legislature enacted provisions for the legislative body of each county in Utah to create agriculture protection areas.

B. The Daggett County Commission anticipates that proposals will be filed under Utah Code Annotated Title 17, Chapter 41 to create agriculture protection areas within Daggett County.

C. Utah Code Annotated § 17-41-201(1) provides that "the county legislative body shall appoint no more than five members from the County's Soil Conservation District Boards of Supervisors to serve as the Agriculture Protection Area Advisory Board."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Daggett County, Utah:

Section 1. Appointment of Agriculture Protection Area Advisory Board. The following persons, each of whom serve on the Board of Supervisors of the Daggett County Soil Conservation District, are hereby appointed as members of the Daggett County Agriculture Protection Area Advisory Board:

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon April 23, 2013

Section 3. Severability. In the event that any provision of the resolution is deemed or held invalid, such portion shall be deemed severable and shall, to the extent possible, be construed separately and independent of any other provision of this resolution. All other provisions of this resolution shall continue in full force and effect, to the extent practicable.

Section 4. Conflicting Actions. To the extent that this resolution conflicts with any prior resolution or other act of the Daggett County Commission of equal or lesser dignity, such other action shall be deemed to conform to and be made in accordance with the provisions of this resolution.
