

ELECTION NOTICE

To all qualified electors of Daggett County, Utah:

Take notice that on the 7th day of February, 1984, a special election shall be held in Daggett County, Utah, at the places set out below for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of Daggett County the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

Shall Daggett County, Utah, be authorized to enter into a contract with the State of Utah, Department of Community and Economic Development and the Permanent Community Impact Fund, for the purpose of acquiring a \$45,000.00 loan to be used for the installation of a television receiver in Daggett County. The \$45,000.00 loan shall be interest free and shall be repayable over a ten (10) year period in ten (10) equal annual installments with the first payment being due on July 1, 1984.

A copy of the proposed contract is available for inspection and review at the Daggett County Courthouse in the Clerk's office.

Said election shall be held at the following polling places, and the persons indicated as follows will act as election officials:

The voting at such special election shall be by ballot, which ballots will be furnished by Daggett County, Utah, to the election officials who, in turn, will furnish them to the qualified voters.

The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

There will be no special registration of voters for the special election and the official register last made or revised shall

constitute the register for such election; except that the County Clerk of Daggett County will register as provided by law at his office during regular office hours, except Saturdays, Sundays, and hol days, and except during the ten-day period immediately preceding the election, any person who is or will be eighteen years or older and who otherwise will be a qualified elector on the day of this election. The County Clerk will make available, at the above-described polling places, a registration list or copy thereof listing all registered voters entitled to use such voting place.

NOTICE is hereby given that on February 15, 1984, that being a day no more than ten (10) days after said election, the Board of County commissioners will meet at its regular meeting place at 2:00 p.m. to canvass the returns and declare the results of said election.

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After the meeting had been duly called to order and the minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved, the following resolution was introduced in writing, read in full and pursuant to motion duly made by Jerry N. Taylor and seconded by Laray Sadlier, adopted by the following vote:

The resolution was then signed by the Chairman and recorded by the Clerk in the official records of Daggett County. The resolution is as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 84-1

A resolution providing for a special election to be held on February 7, 1984, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of Daggett County, Utah, the question of obtaining an interest free loan in the amount of \$45,000.00 from the Community Impact Fund for the installation of television equipment.

WHEREAS, it is desired to submit to the qualified electors of Daggett County the proposition of securing a \$45,000.00 interest free loan from the Community Impact Board, repayable in equal annual installments for ten (10) years, with the first payment being due on July 1, 1984.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Daggett County, Utah, as follows:

1. On the 7 day of February, 1984, there shall be held in Daggett County, Utah, a special election between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at which there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of Daggett County the proposition appearing in the form of the ballot set forth herein.

2. The voting places for said election, the election judges and the alternate election judges to serve at said voting places, each of whom is a qualified elector of Daggett County, shall be those specified in the form of the Notice of Election as set forth herein.

3. Such special election shall be conducted and the registration thereof shall be governed in conformity with the laws of

the State of Utah, including particularly the Utah Municipal bond Act, and the officials of Daggett County shall and are hereby authorized and directed to perform and do all things necessary to the proper calling and conduct of such election and the canvass of the results thereof.

4. Notice of the election shall be published three (3) times, once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks, the first publication to be not less than twenty-one (21) nor more than thirty-five (35) days before the election, in The Vernal Express, a newspaper having general circulation in Daggett County. The Notice shall be in substantially the following form:

There will be no special registration of voters for the special election and the official register last made or revised shall constitute the register for such election; except that the County Clerk of Daggett County will register as provided by law at his office during regular office hours, except Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, and except during the ten-day period immediately preceding the election, any person who is or will be eighteen years or older and who otherwise will be a qualified elector on the day of this election. The County Clerk will make available, at the above-described polling places, a registration list or copy thereof listing all registered voters entitled to use such voting place.

To vote in favor of the loan, place a cross (X) in the square after the words, "For the Loan." To vote against the loan, place a cross (X) in the square after the words, "Against the Loan."

6. Only registered, qualified electors of Daggett County eighteen years of age or older shall be permitted to vote at such election.

7. Immediately after the polls are closed, the election officials shall county and canvass the votes and shall promptly

thereafter certify the results to the Board of County Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners shall meet as a Board within ten (10) days after the date of said election on February 15, 1984, at the hour of 2:00 p.m., at their regular meeting place in Manila, Utah, and if the majority of the votes cast at such election are in favor of the proposition submitted, then the Board of County commissioners shall cause an entry of that fact to be made upon its minutes. Thereupon the Board of County Commissioners shall be authorized and directed to enter into the proposed contract.
