

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE
LICENSING, REGULATION AND CONTROL
OF DOGS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES
FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.
(61-3) FILED DEC. 6, 1961

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DAGGETT COUNTY, UTAH:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to own, keep, hold or harbor any dog within Daggett County, Utah, without first obtaining a license from the County so to do.

SECTION 2. Every dog owner shall annually during the month of January secure a license from Daggett County for said dog. A charge of Two and 50/100 (\$2.50) Dollars for every male dog and spayed female dog and Five and No/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for every female dog will be made for this license.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation transporting a dog into Daggett County shall be required to conform with the above regulations within thirty (30) days.

SECTION 4. At the time of licensing, a suitable and distinctive collar tag shall be issued to the dog owner which collar tag shall be affixed to the dog's collar and must be worn at all times.

Section 5. Any dog found in the County of Daggett not licensed and identified as described in the above provisions shall be impounded by Daggett County and such dog shall be held for a period of five (5) days. The dog may be returned to its owner upon proof of ownership, payment of the cost of impounding the dog, at the rate of One and No/100 (\$1.00) Dollar per day, and payment of any fine assessed under the provisions of this Ordinance and payment of the license fee.

SECTION 6. At the expiration of the five (5) day period, any dog not so claimed by its owner may be disposed of by giving it into the possession of any person willing to pay the cost of impounding and license, or, if not so disposed of, it shall be killed in a humane manner by a peace officer or other designated official.

SECTION 7. Every person who has in his possession or under his control any dog or bitch, within the corporate limits of this city, shall keep any such dog or bitch securely locked up from one hour after sunset of every day until an hour before sunrise of the following day.

SECTION 8. It shall be unlawful for any person to suffer or allow any dog owned by him, in his possession or under his control to run at large within the limits of Daggett County.

SECTION 9. In the enforcement of any provision of this Ordinance, any peace officer or his assistants are authorized to enter the premises of any person to take possession of unlicensed, collarless, fierce, dangerous or vicious dogs when in fresh pursuit of such dog at the time the dog goes onto private property.

SECTION 10. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten and No/100 (\$10.00) Dollars, nor more than Fifty and No/100 (\$50.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the county Jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall take effect Jan. 1, 1962
