

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
DAGGETT COUNTY, UTAH**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 14, 2015, the Board of County Commissioners (the “*Board*”) of Daggett County, Utah (the “*Issuer*”) adopted a resolution (the “*Resolution*”) providing for the issuance and sale of the Issuer’s water revenue bonds (the “*Bonds*”), in an aggregate principal amount of up to \$510,000, and calling a public hearing to receive input from the public with respect to the issuance of the Bonds and the potential economic impact that the Project (defined below) to be financed by the Bonds will have on the private sector, pursuant to the Local Government Bonding Act, Title 11, Chapter 14, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended.

The Issuer intends to issue the Bonds for the purpose of (i) financing certain costs of acquiring and constructing improvements to the Issuer’s water system consisting of the demolition of an existing water tank, the acquisition and construction of a new water tank, improvements to the chlorine disinfection system at the Issuer’s water treatment plant, and related improvements (the “*Project*”), and (ii) paying costs of issuance of the Bonds. The Issuer intends to issue the Bonds in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$510,000.

The Issuer will not pledge any taxes of the Issuer for the payment of the Bonds. Instead, the Issuer will pledge, pursuant to the Resolution, the Revenues derived from the Issuer’s water system for the payment of the Bonds.

The Board will hold a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. on May 19, 2015. The public hearing will be held at the regular meeting place of the Board, located at 95 North 100 West, Manila, Utah. All members of the public are invited to attend and participate in the public hearing. Prior to the public hearing, written comments may be submitted to the Board, to the attention of the Clerk of the Issuer at 95 North 100 West, Manila, Utah 84046.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive input from the public with respect to the issuance of the Bonds for the purpose of financing all or part of the cost of the Project and the potential economic impact that the Project will have on the private sector.
