

2. CONTACT – PAT NICHOLS, HIGH DESERT ANGLERS TO REGISTER YOUR 4 PERSON TEAM. \* COST - \$2,000.00



3. AUGUST 25<sup>TH</sup> – EVENT KICKOFF AT RED CANYON LODGE WITH A DINNER, EVENT ORIENTATION, CASTING GAMES, GUIDE DRAW, AND A PROGRAM ON CONSERVATION.
4. AUGUST 26<sup>TH</sup> – BREAKFAST AT FLAMING GORGE RESORT, FLOAT FISHING THE A AND B SECTIONS, FOLLOWED WITH A BANQUET DINNER, RAFFLE, LIVE AND SILENT AUCTION, AND THE AWARDS CEREMONY.

**\*\$2,000.00 team entry is based on a 4-person team with two team members floating A section and two team members floating B section with guides chosen by random draw or particular guides can be purchased for additional cost.**

# **SINGLE FLY FUNDED PROJECT #1**


**Pot Creek, a tributary to the Green River, flows through Calder Reservoir, a Blue Ribbon status fishery in Utah. It is special regulation water, rich in trout food abundance that has potential to grow large fish. It has a tendency to winterkill due to its shallow nature. High Desert Anglers spent the bulk of 2015 Single Fly proceeds on windmill aerators in an attempt to save the reservoir from certain 2015/2016 winterkill. High Desert Anglers had researched this option, and proposed the idea to the Blue Ribbon Fisheries Advisory Council in the spring of 2015 with an ask for funding of the windmill project. The Blue Ribbon Council denied funding request, so Single Fly funds were put into action for three windmill aerators. The experts say that to prevent any winterkill at a reservoir the size of Calder, ten windmill units will be required. The chapter is pursuing the goal of ten windmills on Calder to prevent future winterkills.**

# SINGLE FLY FUNDED PROJECT #2

The High Desert Anglers Trout Unlimited Chapter, with the use of Single Fly Funding, has paid for new Angler Regulation signage for the Green River. The signage has instigated action from the United States Forest Service to renew and replace their signage, to be in place along the Green River in the near future.

# **POTENTIAL FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR HIGH DESERT ANGLERS WITH SINGLE FLY FUNDS**

## **Opportunity #1 – Continuation with Calder Reservoir Windmill Project**

Our goal is to install and maintain enough windmills on the reservoir to prevent all winterkill. Current estimates are that 10 windmill units are needed to accomplish this goal. High Desert Anglers has submitted a proposal to Utah's Blue Ribbon Fisheries Advisory Council for matching funds to double the Single Fly funding on windmill units at Calder Reservoir. Calder has great potential to grow trout to a large size that attracts anglers from around the United States.

## **Opportunity #2 – Little Hole Trail Rebuild**

The United States Forest Service has secured funding from the Utah's Habitat Council for engineering and redesigning of the Little Hole trail. The opportunity exists for High Desert Anglers to contribute to the construction and material cost of rebuilding the trail. Our Trout Unlimited chapter is coordinating planning efforts with the USFS to be involved with the demolition and rebuilding of the Little Hole Trail regardless of Single Fly funds being donated for this project. The trail is the single most utilized trail in the Ashley National Forest and is a priority for angler access to the Green River.

## **Opportunity #3 – Donate toward purchase of a new electrofishing boat for the Utah Division of Wildlife’s Flaming Gorge Project**

The DWR’s electrofishing boat, used in data collection on the Green River, is past due for renewal. The High Desert Anglers believe that information gathered by the Flaming Gorge Project biologists is vital to maintaining a healthy fishery in this dynamic riverine system. In recent electrofishing efforts, the current boat has had multiple issues resulting in less than desirable data collections. The replacement of this old vessel would be a worthy cause for the use of Single Fly funds.
