

RESOLUTION NO. 07-21

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING STEWART LEITH AS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE OF DAGGETT COUNTY FOR PURCHASING AND TRANSFERRING FEDERAL SURPLUS

Whereas, The United States Federal Government has a program created by Congress for selling federal surplus property, known as The Federal Surplus Property Program.

Whereas, The Federal Surplus Property Program is established to extend the useful life of Federal supplies and equipment for public good, by allowing other public agencies to purchase the property.

Whereas, Daggett county, a political subdivision of the State of Utah, is desirous to be a part of the Federal Surplus Property Program.

Whereas, Daggett County, is in need of appointing a designated representative to secure purchase and/or transfer of surplus Federal property through the Utah State Agency for Surplus property.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

Section 1. Resolution.

It is resolved that Stewart Leith, Chairman of the Daggett County Commission shall be and is hereby designated as the representative of Daggett County to secure the purchase and/or transfer to said Daggett County of surplus Federal property through the Utah State Agency for Surplus Property, under provisions of Section 203(j) of the Federal Property & Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption and publication.
