

**DAGGETT COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 18-15**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE RECERTIFICATION  
OF THE DAGGETT COUNTY JUSTICE COURT**

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of U.C.A. 78A-7-103 require: that Justice Courts be recertified at the end of each four year term; and

**WHEREAS**, the Administrative Office of the Courts has informed the Board of Daggett County Commissioners that it is time to recertify the County's Justice Court; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Board of Daggett County Commissioners have received an opinion letter from the Daggett County Attorney's Office which sets forth the requirements for the operation of a Justice Court and feasibility of continuing to maintain the same; and


**WHEREAS**, the members of the Board of Daggett County Commissioners have determined that it is in the best interest of Daggett County to continue to provide the current justice court system in the county.

**BE IT THEREFORE HEREBY RESOLVED** by the board of Daggett County Commissioners that Daggett County hereby requests recertification of its Justice Court by the Justice Courts Standards Committee and the Utah Judicial Council.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Daggett County Commissioners hereby affirm their willingness to meet all requirements set forth by the Judicial Council, as presented in the August 2018 Recertification packet, for the continued operation of its Justice Court for the next four-year term of court, except as to any requirements waived by the Utah Judicial Council.


