

DAGGETT COUNTY ORDINANCE #17-05
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMIT FOR
COUNTY ROAD #B-18

WHEREAS, the County Commission is authorized under Utah Law with adopting and enacting ordinances to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, improve the moral, peace, good order, comfort, and convenience of the county and its inhabitants, and for the protection of property in the county (Utah Code Ann. § 17-53-223); and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the need for establishing maximum speed limits on its roads to provide for the safety and preserve the health of the county.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the County Legislative Body of Daggett County that the following is hereby adopted regarding Daggett County Speed Limits for County Road #B-18.

SECTION 1 – GENERAL TERMS


1. This ordinance shall apply only to the County Road #B-18, located in Daggett County, Utah, also known as Airport Road.
2. The speed limit for all motor vehicles on County Road #B-18 shall be the reasonable and prudent speed, under existing conditions, not to exceed **25 miles per hour** on the residential portion of the road, and **35 miles per hour** on the remainder of the road.
3. Violations of this ordinance shall be an Infraction, punishable by up to \$120.00.

SECTION 2 – EFFECTIVE DATE

1. As the County Commission deems this ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, or safety of the county and the county's inhabitants, this ordinance shall take immediate effect after posting at the courthouse door. See Utah Code Ann. 17-53-208(6).




